Day 1: Saturday 7 September 2019

Arrive Vancouver (D)

Welcome to Canada! You will be met at Vancouver International Airport and transferred to your hotel. This evening meet your Tour Director and fellow travellers for a welcome dinner. **Two Night Stay:** Sutton Place Hotel

Day 2: Sunday 8 September 2019 Vancouver Sightseeing (HB)

You're Invited: Start the morning with a unique breakfast at the Vancouver Aquarium where there is an opportunity to view a variety of

marine life from all over the planet. Later enjoy a sightseeing tour of Vancouver including Stanley Park with its intricately carved totem poles, the waterfront area, Gastown with its lively shops and restaurants and Granville Island which is famous for its fresh food markets. Visit the Capilano Suspension Bridge Park where you can make your way across this spectacular suspension bridge, 70 metres above the Capilano River, and join the award winning Treetops Adventure along a series of elevated walkways.

Day 3: Monday 9 September 2019

Rocky Mountaineer – Kamloops (B,L) Set off on a two day rail experience on "The Most Spectacular Train Journey in the World". Settle back in your GoldLeaf carriage as you enter the Fraser Valley then follow the Thompson River towards Kamloops. **Overnight Stay:** Kamloops Hotel (as assigned by Rocky Mountaineer)

Day 4: Tuesday 10 September 2019

Rocky Mountaineer – Lake Louise (B,L,D) Continue your journey into the soaring, rugged snow-capped mountains. Marvel at the beauty of the glaciers, lakes and forest sitting at the foot of these grand mountains before arriving into the beautiful Lake Louise. Prepare yourself for one of the highlights of your journey as you arrive at Canada's "Diamond in the Wilderness". Two Night Stay: Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise

Day 5: Wednesday 11 September 2019 Lake Louise (B)

Lake Louise enjoys picture perfect surroundings. Spend the day exploring the lake and soaking up the spectacular scenery.

Day 6: Thursday 12 September 2019 Lake Louise – Banff (B,D)

Bid farewell to Lake Louise and make your way to Banff. See the glacier fed Emerald Lake and the spectacular Natural Bridge, which has been carved by the Kicking Horse River. On arrival into Banff enjoy an afternoon sightseeing tour including the Bow River, the Hoodoos and Bow Falls, then take the Banff Gondola to the top of Sulphur Mountain where you will witness inspiring views over the surrounding peaks and valleys. The next two days you will stay at the "Castle in the Rockies", one of the most iconic and impressive hotels in Canada. **Two Night Stay:** Fairmont Banff Springs Hotel

Day 7: Friday 13 September 2019 Banff at Leisure (B)

Banff is a picturesque town located within Banff National park and is the quintessential Rocky Mountains town. Today is for you to enjoy Banff and its many sights and attractions. **Discover More:** Discover wolfdogs, take a breath-taking helicopter flight over inspiring mountain scenery, enjoy an outback dinner and wagon ride, or relax on a float trip along the river (additional cost).

Day 8: Saturday 14 September 2019 Glacier 'Ice Explorer' – Jasper (B)

This morning we travel north along the Icefields Parkway, acclaimed as one of the most spectacular journeys in the world. Enjoy breath-taking mountain scenery as you pass rugged peaks and glaciers fringed by thick forest and shimmering lakes. Day 9: Sunday 15 September 2019 Jasper (B,HD)

Today you have the opportunity to explore Jasper and it's surrounds. **You're Invited:** This evening we journey to the foothills of Pyramid Mountain and experience an authentic Canadian Rockies Western style dinner followed by a wildlife and wilderness presentation and a short forest walk to try to find an icon of Canada, the beaver (Jasper Stables dinner is seasonal and may not be available on early and late season departures, enquire for details). **Discover More:** Discover Jasper wilderness and wildlife tour, float trip along the Athabasca River or authentic Canadian canoe adventure (additional cost).

Day 10: Monday 16 September 2019

Jasper – Okanagan – Kelowna (B,L,D) Depart Jasper and head past the awesome, 3,954 metre Mt. Robson. Continue through the Cariboo Mountains region and into the lush Okanagan Valley to Kelowna. Visit one of Kelowna's award-winning wineries and sample some of the local wines. Overnight Stay: The Cove Lakeside Resort

Day 11: Tuesday 17 September 2019 Kelowna – Whistler (B,HD)

Travel through scenic landscapes as the road meanders alongside the Nicola River and through sandstone chasms. Follow the Thompson and Fraser River past the town of Lillooet to the charming alpine resort of Whistler. **You're Invited**: Head to the Squamish Lil'wat Cultural Centre for an authentic First Nations BBQ where you will learn about the history and culture of the native Canadians. **Two Night Stay:** Four Seasons Whistler





Day 12: Wednesday 18 September 2019 Whistler at Leisure (B)

Today is at leisure for you to explore the resort village of Whistler. **Discover More:** Special opportunity to undertake a bear viewing tour with a local expert (seasonal option), take a Callaghan Jeep tour, or have dinner with a twist on a tasting tour (additional cost).

Day 13: Thursday 19 September 2019 Georgia Strait – Victoria (B)

View this spectacular landscape from the air with a one hour floatplane flight over the Georgia Strait to Whistler (seasonal, must be pre-booked, additional cost).

Travel along the Sea to Sky Highway following the rugged coastline stopping at the awesome Shannon Falls. Board the BC ferry and cruise through the Georgia Strait to Vancouver Island before arriving into Victoria, British Columbia's capital city. **Discover More**: Culinary dinner tour (additional cost). **Two Night Stay:** The Inn at Laurel Point

Day 14: Friday 20 September 2019

Victoria Sightseeing – Butchart Gardens (B,D) This morning visit the world-famous Butchart Gardens, a 22 hectare showplace of magnificent, colourful gardens. Learn about the history and flora while exploring the gardens. Afterwards enjoy an orientation tour of Victoria's Inner Harbour, Bastion Square, Beacon Hill and residential areas. Today is a day of relaxation as you cruise south to the stunning capital of British Columbia, Victoria.
